Focus on Laser (FT) College and Laser (FT) Basic Skills Students

To answer these questions, we identified ten unique groups of students and are following their progress towards their goals. Each group has a different educational goal, pace of progress (units) and starting place (English assessment).

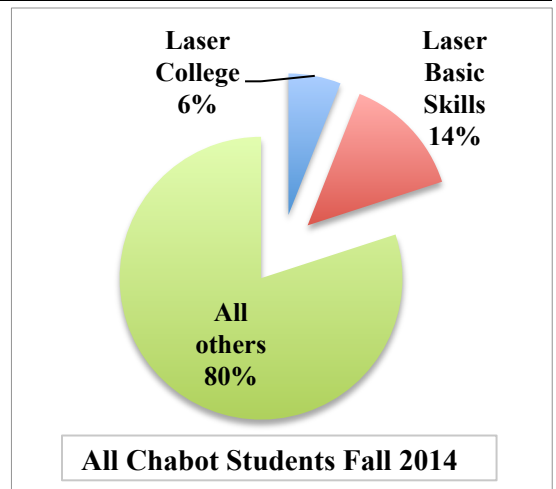
This page focuses on *Laser* students. Lasers are *full-time* students with an educational goal of transfer or AA degree. They are called *Lasers* because they have a clear goal and are moving as fast as possible towards it.

Laser College students and *Laser Basic Skills* students are starting English at either College or Basic Skills level.

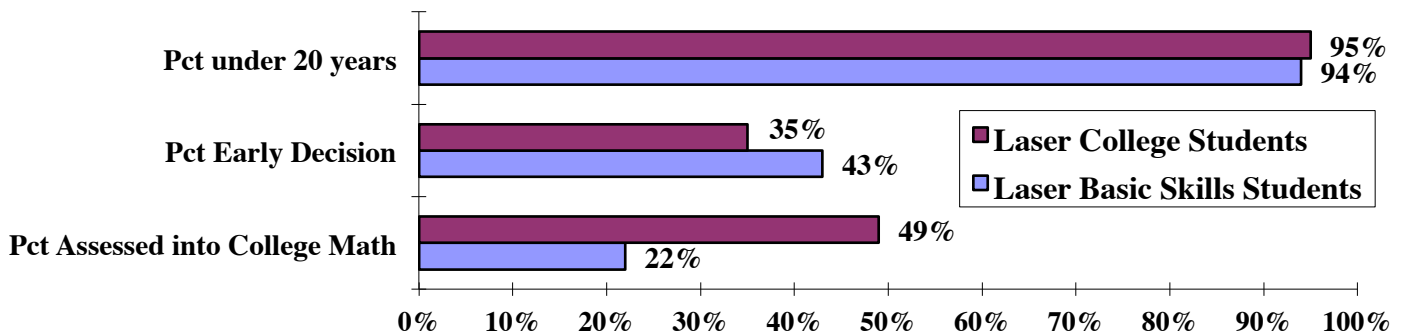
Only 6% of Chabot students are *Laser College*; 14% are *Laser Basic Skills*. *Laser College* students are more likely than other groups to complete English 1A, a major milestone on the way to transfer/degree – can you see why?
