

# Chabot College Student Educational Goal Groups

## Focus on Seeker (PT) College and Seeker (PT) Basic Skills Students

Our Strategic Plan goal is:

*"Increase the number of students that achieve their educational goal within a reasonable time."*

But students have different educational goals! What number should increase? What is a reasonable time?

To answer these questions, we identified ten unique groups of students and are following their progress towards their goals. Each group has a different educational goal, pace of progress (units) and starting place (English assessment).

This page is about *Seeker* students. Seekers are *part-time* students with an educational goal of *transfer or AA degree*

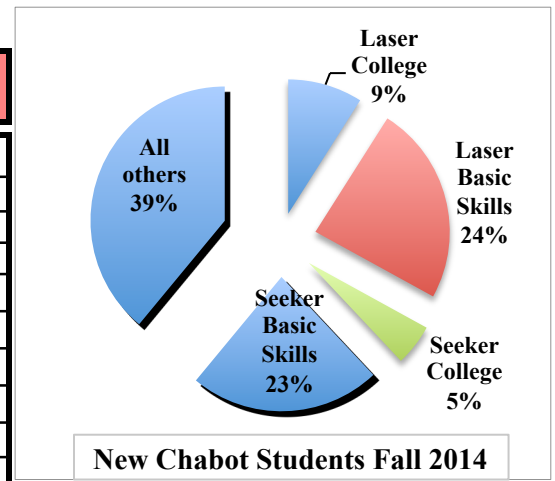
They are called *Seekers* because they have a clear goal, but attending part-time makes it challenging to reach it.

Like *Laser* students, *Seekers* start English at either *College* or *Basic Skills* level. Of new Chabot students, 5% are *Seeker College* and 23% are *Seeker Basic Skills*. *Laser* and *Seeker Basic Skills* make up 47% of new students.

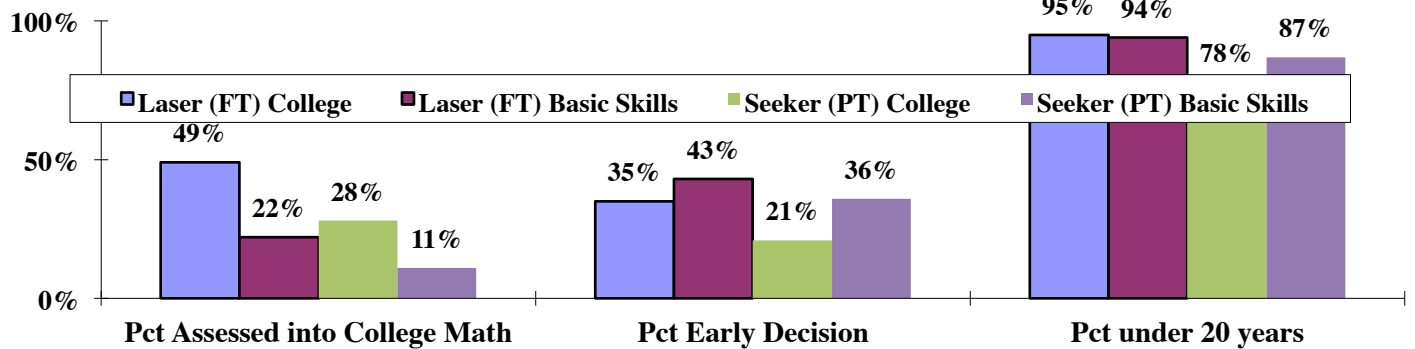
However, *Seeker Basic Skills* are much less likely to complete English 1A than *Lasers* or *Seeker College* students.
