## Persistence rates of new students by gender and race-ethnicity Fall 2000 to Spring 2001 through Fall 2013 to Spring 2014

Persistence rates measure the proportion of students in one term who continue to enroll in college from one term to the next. Term to term persistence rates are defined as the percentage of students enrolled as of Census Day in the first term who are subsequently enrolled as of Census Day in the following term.

Usually, about two thirds of new Chabot students in the Fall persist to the Spring semester. As of Fall 2013, the persistence rate of new students had dropped to 69 percent from 75 percent the previous Fall. Students in most of the race-ethnicity groups persisted at a rate near or above this average. However, for the last fourteen years, African-American students have had persistence rates lower than the average rate, many times at least 10 percentage points lower.
