

## Chabot College Wage Gains of Skills Builder Students

Chabot Skills Builder students in 2012-13 averaged an 18% wage gain after coursework here. For Skills Builders in all California Community Colleges (CCCs), the wage gain was 13%.

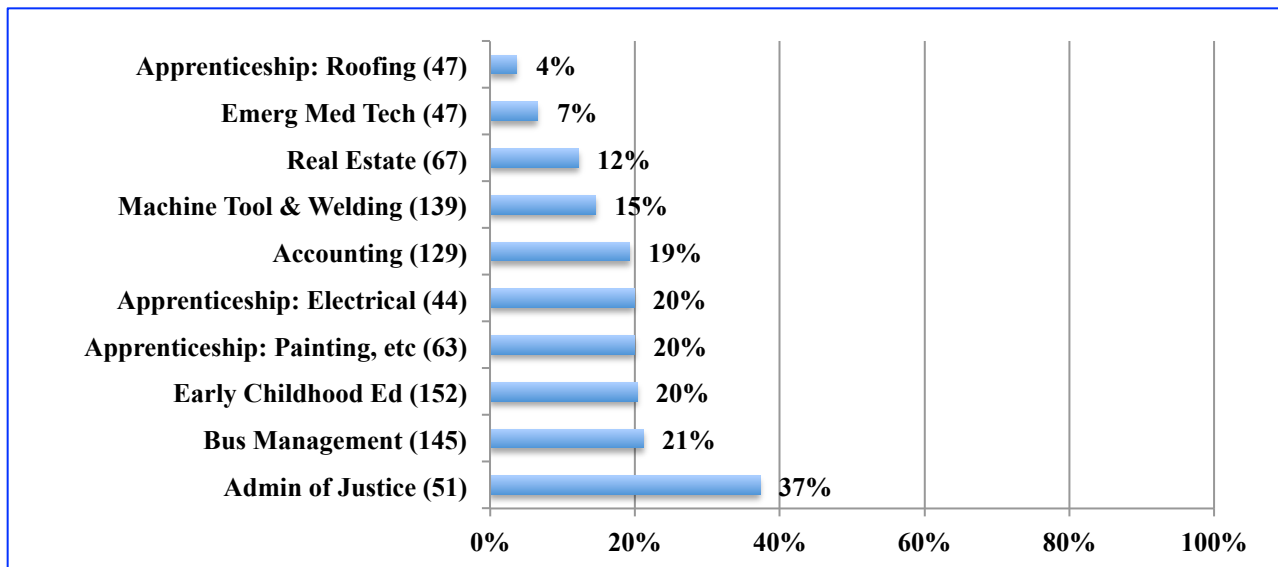
- SKILLS BUILDERS:**
- attend Chabot in order to enhance or advance their job skills.
  - complete a limited number of CTE courses in one year, and leave.
  - do not go to any other CCC, or obtain a certificate, degree, or transfer.

**WAGE GAINS:** The median pct. change in wages from year before to year after Chabot.

The CCC Chancellor's Office is now including Skills Builder wage gains on the Student Success Scorecard (see Sources below). This gives colleges a way to show the value gained by the many students who just take one or two courses in our Career & Technical Education (CTE) programs.

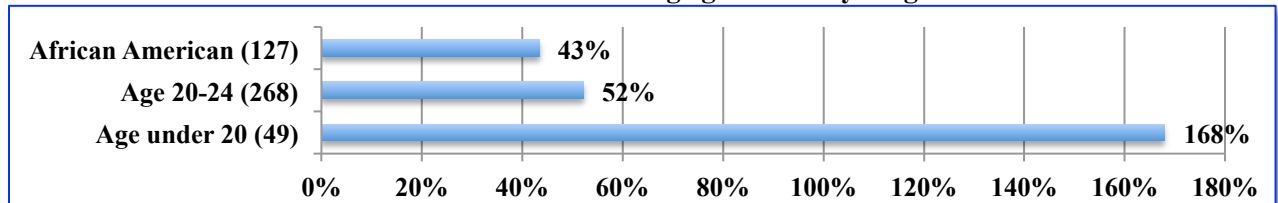
There are often more Skills Builders than completers, and they are just being recognized now. At Chabot in 2012-13, there were 1,033 Skills Builders, while 297 students earned certificates.
