
## African American Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of African American students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. African American students have lower success rates and lower persistance rates than all Chabot students. Among African American students, success rates are highest among 40 or older students and continuing students. Persistence rates are highest among new students 19 or younger, continuing students, and new students with transfer degree goals.
