
Native American Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Native American students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Native American students have higher success rates and similar persistence rates as all Chabot students. Success rates are highest among younger students ages 40 or older. Due to the decreasing and small number of Native American students at Chabot, persistence rates could only be calculated for some groups. Among Native American students, persistence rates were highest for female students with transfer goals.
