



Chabot College Transfer Rates 2000-01 to 2007-08 Entering Cohorts

Chabot College students transfer to U.S. four-year colleges at a rate slightly higher than or equal to students at all California Community Colleges (CCCs). Chabot African American and Latino students usually transfer at higher rates than their counterparts in all CCCs; however, African American rates have recently dropped. This transfer rate is calculated for "transfer-directed*" students. i.e., those who have completed 12 units and attempted a transfer-level English or Math course within 6 years of entering Chabot. The transfer rate is the percentage of transfer-directed students who transferred to any 4-year college in the U.S. within a number of years after entering Chabot. For the latest entering cohorts, Chabot's transfer rate has been about 25 percent after 4 years, and 40 percent after 6 years. However, the latest transfer rate for African American and Latino students is only 30 percent after six years.
