**VARIABLE TOPIC COURSES**

Variable topic courses **rarely transfer**, so students **should not include ANY units** from these courses **toward the 60 UC transferable units required for admission**.

Variable topic courses are also called: Colloquia (at Chabot, courses numbered “9”), Contemporary Studies (at Chabot, courses numbered “49”), Independent Studies (at Chabot, courses numbered “29”), Special Studies, Special Topics, Internships, etc. *Variable topic courses can be offered under any academic discipline.*

Credit for variable topic courses may be given only after a review of the course outline by the enrolling UC campus. This usually occurs after transfer and may include recommendation from faculty.

Credit will not be given for variable topic courses in: Journalism, Photography, Health, Business Administration, Architecture, Administration of Justice (Criminology), Library Science, and other disciplines due to the UC credit restrictions in these areas. This policy began Fall 2001.
