

THESE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS APPLY TO STUDENTS WHO FIRST ENROLLED IN ANY COLLEGE PRIOR TO SEPTEMBER 1983 AND REMAIN IN CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT (EXCEPT SUMMER).

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DEGREE OF ASSOCIATE IN ARTS

A student is eligible for graduation with the Associate in Arts Degree after satisfactorily completing 90 quarter units of work with a 2.0 average or better and has met the specific requirements outlined below:

I GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

***AMERICAN INSTITUTIONS.....7 UNITS**

- Complete one of the following combinations:
1. Political Science 1 and one course selected from (a) or (b):
 - (a) Political Science 2, 3, 4, 5, 12, 21
 - (b) History 21A, 21B, 22, 23, or 25.
 2. Political Science 1 and History 17B and 17C.
 3. History 17A, 17B, and 17C
NOTE: History 21A, 21B, 22, 25 or 26 may be substituted for any one quarter of the History 17 series.
 4. Political Science 30A and 30B.

ENGLISH COMPOSITION AND/OR SPEECH.....7 UNITS

A test of English skills is required for entry into English 1A or 52A. For information about testing, please call 786-6718 or 786-6804 Hayward Campus, or 455-5300, extension 22 Valley Campus, or inquire at the Counseling Lobby of either campus.

- Complete one of the following combinations:
1. English 1A and 1B.
 2. English 1A and Speech 1.
 3. English 52A and 52B or 70 and one course from: English 53, Speech 1, 10, 30, 45, 46.
 4. English 1A and 70 and one course from: English 53, Speech 10, 30, 45, 46.

HEALTH EDUCATION.....3 UNITS

- Complete one of the following:
1. Health 1.
 2. The A.A. Degree in Nursing or Dental Hygiene.
 3. Verification of one year active military service (file a copy of your DD-214 with the Admissions & Records office, Building 100).

***HUMANITIES.....4 UNITS**

- Complete either 1 or 2 below:
1. Complete one course from the following:
 - Art 30
 - Creative Arts 10
 - Drama 10, 12
 - English 17, 25, 30A, 30B, 30C, 40, 46A, 46B, 46C, 47
 - French 2A
 - German 2A
 2. Complete two courses including at least one from (a):
 - (a) Art 6, 8, 11, 26
 - Drama 15, 25
 - English 26, 45, 54
 - History 4A, 4B, 4C
 - Humanities 1, 3, 5, 10
 - Music 1, 2, 3

MATHEMATICS. The requirement of minimum proficiency in Mathematics may be met by either a satisfactory score on the SCAT Test (or ACT or SAT) or passing Mathematics 50 or higher or Business 54 or 55 with a grade of "C" or better. To take the SCAT Test, register in Room 192, Hayward campus, or Building 700, Valley campus.

- Complete one course from the following list:

PHYSICAL EDUCATION. Students under age 21 who are enrolled in 9 or more day units are required to take a Physical Education course each quarter. Exemption is allowed for illness or physical disability by filing a physician's statement in the Admissions & Records office, Building 100. Students under age 21 who hold an A.A. Degree or higher are also exempt.

Physical Education courses may be selected from:
Physical Education 1, 2, 18-19, 22-23ABCD, 25AB, 26AB, 30-42, 44-49.

- Complete one course from the following list:

*A course in Ethnic Studies may be credited, as appropriate, towards the completion of requirements in American Institutions, Social Sciences, or Humanities. **May be used to meet either the Natural Sciences or Social Sciences requirement.

II ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. For career majors (see TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL programs on colored pages in the center of the Chabot College catalog), all requirements for the major must be met plus electives to total 90 quarter units.
2. For other students, appropriate transfer requirements and/or electives to total 90 quarter units. See a counselor for information and advice on transfer requirements.
3. Students with previous college credits must have taken at least 18 quarter units at Chabot College and must meet the specific requirements outlined above. All transcripts from other colleges must be submitted to the Admissions & Records office, Building 100, before a graduation evaluation may be made.

III OTHER GRADUATION INFORMATION

1. Commencement exercises are held in June. All students receiving degrees during the preceding academic year are cordially invited to participate.
2. Students may receive degrees or certificates at the end of any quarter or the summer session. Students should petition for graduation no later than the first instructional week of the quarter in which they plan to complete the requirements. Forms for this purpose are available in the Admissions & Records office, Building 100.

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
