## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DEGREE OF ASSOCIATE IN ARTS

A student is eligible for graduation with the Associate in Arts Degree after satisfactorily completing 90 quarter units of work with a 2.0 average or better and meeting the specific requirements outlined below:

### I MATHEMATICS

The requirement of minimum proficiency in mathematics may be met by either a satisfactory score on a placement examination or passing one of the following courses with a grade of "C" or higher or "CR": Mathematics 2A, 2B, 26, 33, 36, 40, 42A, 46, 56, 60A, 60B, 71, Business 55, Electronics Technology 65A or 65B, Industrial Technology 74 or Psychology 5. For the A.A. in Nursing only, Math 72 may be substituted for any one of the above courses. For information about the examination, consult the Counselor Assistant.

### III PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students under age 21 who are enrolled in six day units or less are required to take a Physical Education course each quarter. Exemption is allowed for illness or physical disability by filing a physician's statement at the Admissions & Records Office of either college. Students under age 21 who hold an A.A. Degree or higher are also exempt. Complete three units selected from:

\*\* May be used to meet either the Natural Sciences or Social & Behavioral Sciences requirement.

### II. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. For other students, appropriate transfer requirements and/or electives to total 90 quarter units. See a counselor for information and advice on transfer requirements.
2. Students with previous college credits must have taken at least 18 quarter units at Chabot College and must meet the specific requirements outlined above. All transcripts from other colleges must be submitted to the Admissions & Records Office before a graduation evaluation may be made.

### III. OTHER GRADUATION INFORMATION

1. Commencement exercises are held in June. All students receiving degrees during the preceding academic year are cordially invited to participate.
2. Students may receive degrees or certificates at the end of any quarter or the summer session. Students should petition for graduation no later than the first instructional week of the quarter in which they plan to complete the requirements. Forms for this purpose are available at the Admissions & Records Office.
3. Students must submit a "Petition for the A.A. Degree" or Certificate to the Admissions and Records Office during the first three (3) weeks of the quarter in which they anticipate that all requirements will be met.

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
