**REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DEGREE OF ASSOCIATE IN ARTS**

A student is eligible for graduation with the Associate in Arts Degree after satisfactorily completing no fewer than 60 semester units of work with a 2.0 cumulative average or better, all the requirements for that major and meeting the specific requirements outlined below:

**I. GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

**AMERICAN INSTITUTIONS . . . . . 6 SEM UNITS**

Complete one of the following combinations:

1. Political Science 1 (Chabot course) *or* 7 (LPC course) and History 8.
2. History 7 and 8 (Note: History 12, 20, 21, 22, 25 or 26 may be substituted for History 8.)
3. Political Science 1 (Chabot course) *or* 7 (LPC course) and one course from the following:  
     Political Science 12, 20, 25, 30, 40  
     History 12, 20, 21, 22, 25, 26.

## MATHEMATICS

The requirement of minimum proficiency in mathematics may be met by passing one of the following courses with a grade of "C" or higher or "CR": Mathematics 1, 2, 20, 26, 33, 36, 40, 42A, 55, 55AB, 57, 58, 65, 71, Business 55, Electronics Technology 50 or 65, Industrial Technology 74 or Psychology 5. For the A.A. in Nursing only, Mathematics 72 may be substituted for any one of the above courses.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION..... 2 SEM UNITS

Students under age 21 who are enrolled in 6 day semester units or more are required to take a Physical Education course each semester. Exemption is allowed for illness or physical disability by filing a physician's statement at the Admissions & Records Office. Students under age 21 who hold an A.A. Degree or higher are also exempt. Complete two semester units selected from: Physical Education 1, 2, 3, 12, 30-48, Dance 1.

## SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES..... 3 SEM UNITS

Complete 3 Semester units from the following\*:

Anthropology 1, 2, 3, 5

Business 30

Economics 1, 2, 10

Geography 1\*\*, 2, 3

Psychology 1, 50

Sociology 1, 4, 11

\*One of the following courses in Ethnic Studies may be credited towards the completion of requirements in Social & Behavioral Sciences: History 20, 21, 22, 25, 26 or Political Science 40, Psychology 18, or Sociology 3.

\*\*May be used to meet either the Natural Sciences or Social & Behavioral Sciences requirement.

## II. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. For career majors (see Occupational Education on page 125 of the college catalog), all requirements for the major must be met plus electives to total 60 semester units.
2. In reference to unit requirements the Title V regulations state that at least 12 semester units must be completed in residence at the college granting the degree.
3. All transcripts from other colleges must be submitted to the Admissions and Records Office before a graduation evaluation may be made.

## III. OTHER GRADUATION INFORMATION

1. Commencement exercises are held in late May or early June. All students receiving degrees during the current academic year are cordially invited to participate.
2. Students may receive degrees or certificates at the end of any semester or the summer session. Students should petition no later than the eight instructional week of the semester in which they plan to complete the requirements. "Request for course evaluation for AA/AS degree or certificate" forms are available at the Admissions & Records Office.
