IMPORTANT NOTES:**Variable Topics Courses:**

These courses are also called "Independent Studies", "Special Studies", "Special Topics", "Internships", etc. Credit for variable topics courses is given only after a review of the course outline by the enrolling UC campus. This usually occurs after transfer and may include recommendations from faculty. Credit will not be given for variable topic courses in Journalism, Photography, Health, Business Administration, Architecture, Administration of Justice (Criminology) or Library Departments due to the credit restrictions in those areas. This policy is effective Fall 2001.

Chabot Variable Topics Courses include:

- Colloquia - courses numbered 9
- Contemporary Studies - courses numbered 49
- Independent Study - courses numbered 29 and 38

Credit Limitations:

Limitations on the number of units that can be transferred to UC have been removed from Art, Music, and Theater Arts; however, students are cautioned from completing an excessive number of units in these areas. It is expected that students will plan their transfer program carefully and will enroll in general education as well as courses preparatory for their intended major at UC. Please consult your counselor for answers to any questions you may have about this matter.
