Labor Market Information (LMI) and Analysis

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Engineering Design workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda, Contra Costa counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 555 students in the Bay region and 151 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.
