### > CTE Vision and Talking points

- the "second-class/stepchild" narrative associated with CTE/CE and the challenge of programs operating in silos, which makes it difficult to tell a cohesive story.
- 60% of students are in CTE programs. In 2023-24, CTE accounted for 55% of certificates and 39% of all degrees and certificates
- how students should describe their experience, the transformation they undergo, and the future vision for the programs.
- Want students to describe their experience as "streamlined,"
   "supported," and leading to immediate job placement
- The vision for CTE should focus on amplifying the value of a community college degree, highlighting employment and pay outcomes, and further building industry connections.
