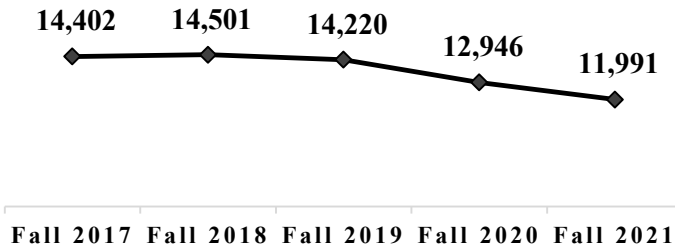

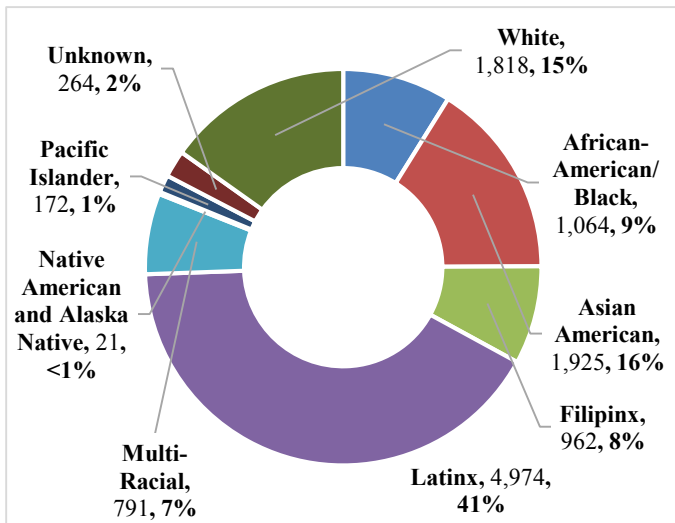

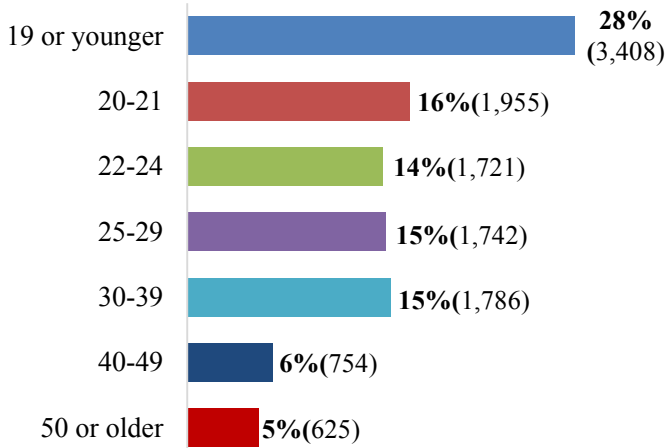
Five-Year Trend (Headcount)



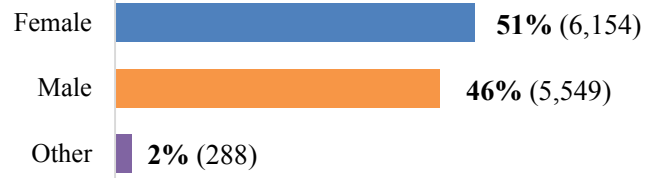
Race-Ethnicity

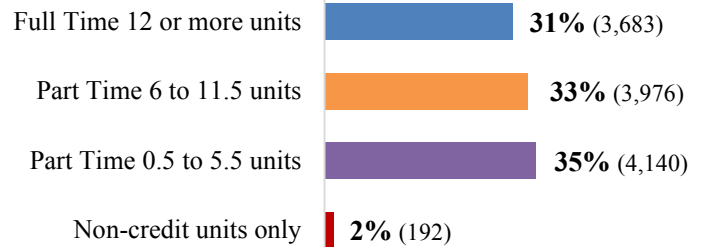

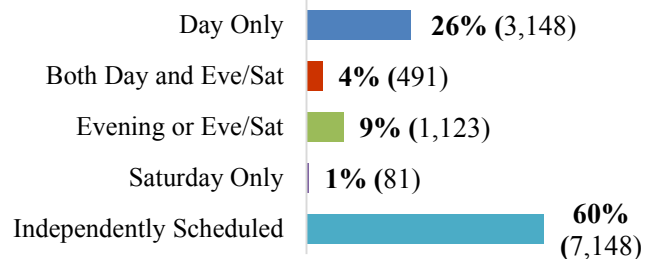

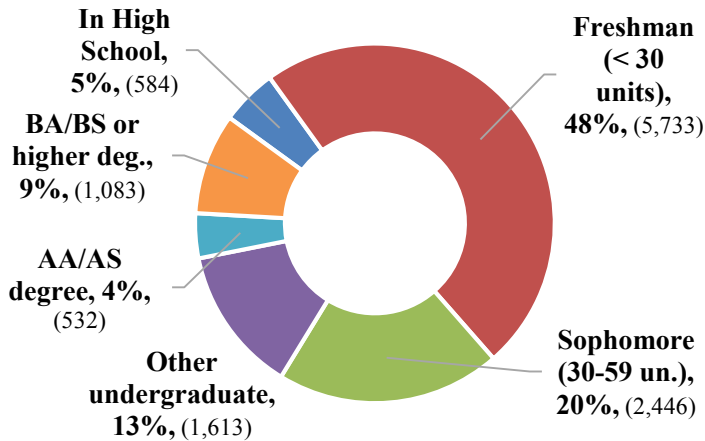
