### English Assessment: Fall 2015-2018 Changes and Results

For Fall 2015-18, the English/ESL faculty and the SSSP Advisory Group approved the following changes to the English Assessment test:		
<b>Fall 15 Changes</b>	<b><i>Changes from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 in Cut Score to be placed into English 1A:</i></b>	Accuplacer Reading Score lowered from 85 to 80 Accuplacer Sentence Structure Score lowered from 95 to 80
<b>Fall 16 Changes</b>	<b><i>Changes from Fall 2015 to Fall 2016 in Cut Score to be placed into English 1A:</i></b>	NO CHANGE in Reading Score or Sentence Structure Score ADDED Reading Score $\geq$ 40 and a H.S. GPA of 3.5 or higher
<b>Fall 17 &amp; 18 Changes</b>	<b><i>Changes from Fall 2016 to Fall 2017 &amp; Fall 2018</i></b>	NO CHANGE in Eng 1A Cut Score or H.S. GPA of 3.5 or higher Low-scoring ESL students branched down to ESL test, so not included in total.
