The campaign to get more Chabot students to apply for financial aid has been successful! In Fall 2000, 78 pct. did not apply; now only 48 pct. do not. The percentage of Chabot students who applied for financial aid has more than doubled in the last 18 years from 22 percent to 52 percent. The number of applications has risen from 3,195 in Fall 2000, to 7,551 in Fall 2017— nearly two and a half times as many as in 2000. The percentage of Chabot students who were offered preliminary financial aid has increased, from 20 percent or less until 2008 to 33 percent by 2017. Even though one third of those who apply are not offered any aid, the financial aid staff still has to process the 7,551 who apply.
