Chabot College First Generation College Students by Race-Ethnicity: Fall 2020


In the California Community College Student Success Metrics Dashboard, first-generation status is defined as a student for whom no parent or guardian has earned more than a high school diploma and who has no college experience. By this definition, 45%(fall 2019*)-43%(fall 2020) of Chabot students would be considered first generation. First generation is also commonly defined in federal grants and reports as a student for whom no parent or guardian has earned a bachelor's degree; thus, students who have at least one parent/guardian with some college experience or even an associate's degree would still be considered first generation. By this definition, 73%(fall 2019*)-71%(fall 2020) of Chabot students would be considered first generation. Further, first generation status varies by students' racial and ethnic backgrounds. Defining first generation as neither parent/guardian having a bachelor's degree, in fall 2020, Latinx (86%), Pacific Islander (85%) and Native American/Alaska Native (80%) students are most likely to be first generation, whereas White (56%) and Filipinx students (45%) are least likely to be first generation. Regardless of how first generation is defined, it is clear that Chabot needs to ensure we have strong programs and services in place to support our first generation students.
