Trends in High School Districts of First-time College Students: Fall 2000-2021

New first-time college students make up about 19% of the student body, and for the last 21 years they have come from a similar mix of high school districts. Until Fall 2008, barely half of Chabot first-time college students came from high schools in the Chabot College District. Since then, the percentage from local high schools has been over half of new Chabot students, reaching an all time high of 61% in Fall 2019. Only 11% came from high schools in other parts of Alameda County, a decline from 21 percent in Fall 2004. About 18% came from other parts of the Bay Area or elsewhere in California. The percentage of new students who went to high school in a different country is about 4%.
