

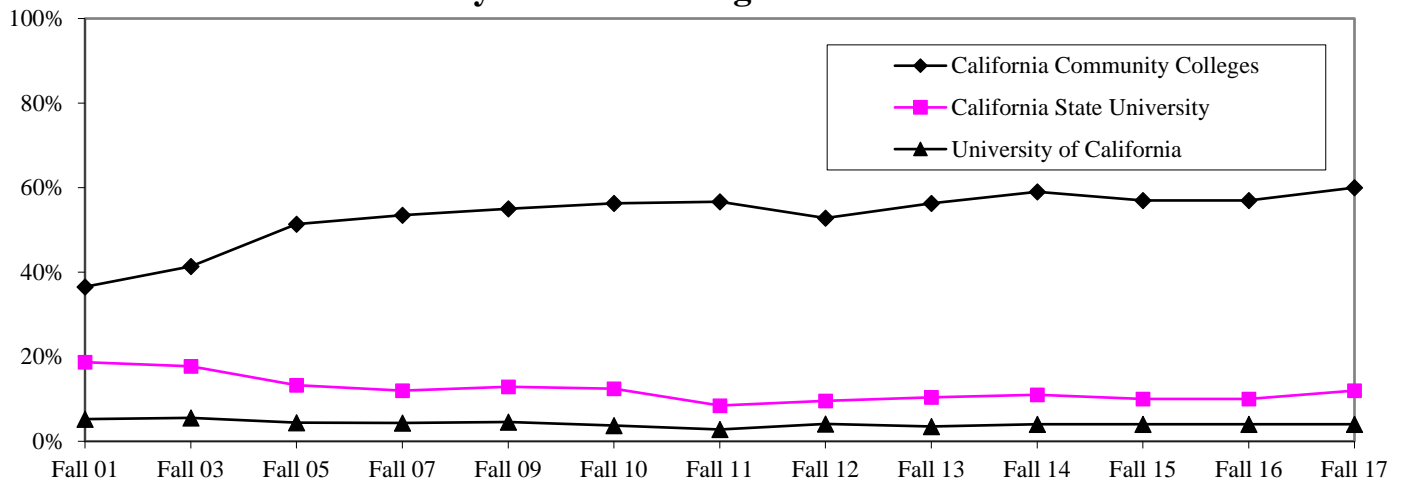
Chabot College Trends in Previous College of Transfer Students: Fall 2001-2017

Students who transfer into Chabot from other colleges comprise about 21 percent of the student body, and the colleges they come from have changed somewhat in the last 16 years. More than half of the transfers now come from other California community colleges; this percentage used to be about 40 percent. The percentage of transfers from CSU has declined from 19 percent to 12 percent, while the percentage for UC has remained at 4 percent.
