Chabot College Student Satisfaction Survey: Fall 2011 Highlights

Involvement in Extra-carricular Activities

One quarter to one third of Chabot students participate in student clubs, ASCC, or Athletics, volunteer in a community organization, or tutor other students, participating in these activities either often or sometimes.

The core group of Chabot students who keep these activities going are the solid 15 percent who often participate in clubs, ASCC or Athletics, the 14 percent who often volunteer in the community, and the 11 percent who often tutor other students.



Fall 2011 Volunteered in a Community Organization


