

# Chabot College Student Satisfaction Survey: Fall 2017

## Highlights

### Changes in Overall Student Satisfaction with Chabot

Overall student satisfaction with Chabot keeps rising, according to the Fall 2017 Student Satisfaction Survey. Eighty-six percent of Chabot students were satisfied or very satisfied with the college, the highest since 2001. Satisfaction with instructors increased from 81 percent in 2015 to 84 percent in 2017. Students also reported higher satisfaction with their progress towards educational goals, preparation for transfer, and preparation for jobs.

In 2017, two large increases in satisfaction stood out—satisfaction with Technology Labs (Auto, Elec, Machine Tool, and Welding) rose 13 pct. points, and satisfaction with preparation for obtaining employment rose 8 points.

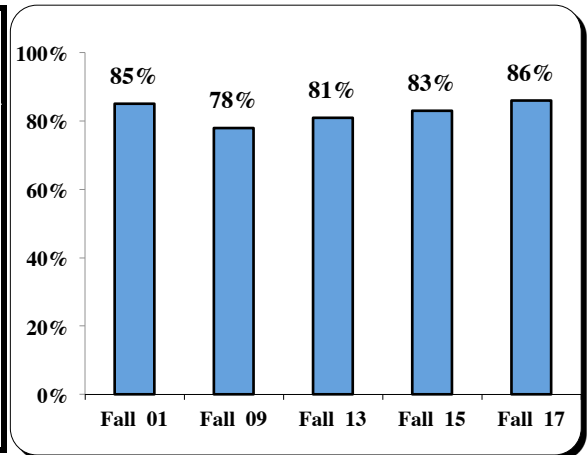
The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted in October 2017 in a representative sample of 77 on-campus course sections. Surveys were completed by 1,702 students (59% full-time; 41% part-time).

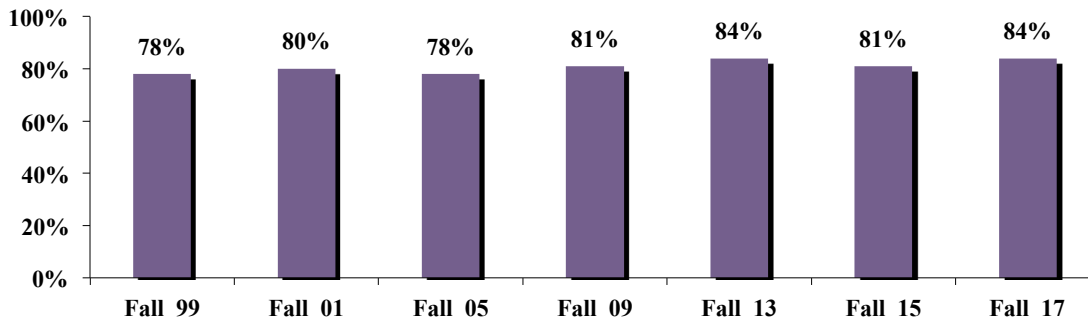
