


## Chabot College Survey of Spring 2021 Degree and Certificate Graduates

The Spring 2021 Transfer/Graduation Survey was completed by 484 students. This handout summarizes the results for the 454 students who received a degree or certificate--of whom 261 students received a degree or certificate *and* transferred (referred to as Degree/Cert & Transfer below) and 196 students received a degree or certificate but did not transfer (referred to as Degree/Cert Only below). The majority of degree earners completed their programs within four and a half years (64% for degree only students and 84% for degree & transfer students). For certificate earners, 74% of them completed their programs within three and a half years. While at Chabot, over half of the students attended every term, and the majority of them attended full-time or mix of full-time and part-time, whether or not they were working.
