
# Asian Students at Chabot College: Success and Persistence

These tables show the latest course success and persistence rates of Asian students at Chabot by gender, age, student type, and educational goal. Asian students have higher success rates and higher persistence rates than all Chabot students. Among Asian students, success rates are highest among women, continuing students, students 30 years or older, and those with AA/AS degree and job training goals. Persistence rates are highest among women and men 21 years or younger, new and returning students 19 years or younger, and new students with job training and transfer goals.
