



# Success Rates by Course Modality and Race/Ethnicity Spring 2022-Fall 2022

Course success rates vary by students' racial and ethnic groups and by course modality. Across all modalities, the overall success rates are higher in Spring 2022 than Fall 2022. (Higher course success rates in spring is a trend also seen pre-Covid.) In Spring and Fall 2022, face-to-face courses have higher success rates than courses of other modalities for most racial/ethnic groups (e.g., African American/Black, Latino/a/x, Pacific Islander (Fall 2022 only), and White). For Asian American and Filipino/a/x students, this trend does not hold; the success rates in face-to face and online sync courses are usually higher than courses of other modalities.

Notes: 1. Success rates are hidden when cohort sizes are smaller than 10.

2. The total enrollments in this report might be lower than those in the enrollment report because some grades (such as RD) and blank grades were excluded from the total. 3. This report does not show courses with no modality information contained in the IR dataset, such as apprenticeship classes, dual enrollment classes, and Sheriff's Academy classes. (However, all courses are included in the calculation of "overall success rates by race/ethnicity.")

\* The cohort size for Native American/Alaska Native is significantly smaller than the cohort sizes for other racial and ethnic groups. In general, one can expect metrics for larger group sizes to be more stable and metrics for smaller group sizes to fluctuate.
