


Chabot College Survey of Spring 2019 Transfer Students

The Spring 2019 Transfer/Graduation Survey was completed by 337 students. This handout summarizes the results for the 212 students who transferred--of whom 183 transferred and received a degree and/or certificate along the way (referred to as *Transfer & Degree/Cert* below) and 29 transferred without getting a degree or certificate (referred to as *Transfer Only* below). Survey respondents represent 22% of the 955 transfer students from Chabot in 2018-19. About 84% of transfer-only students completed their programs within three and a half years, whereas about 70% of transfer & degree/cert students completed within the same time period. While at Chabot, the majority of students attended every term (84% for transfer-only students vs. 62% for transfer & degree/cert students). In comparison to transfer & degree/cert students, transfer-only students tended to be younger and attend school full-time. Although close to 90% of transfer students plan to attend their 4-year institutions full-time, the majority of these students also plan to work in Fall 2019.
