


## Chabot College Transfer Velocity Rates 2000-01 to 2010-11 Entering Cohorts


Chabot College students transfer to U.S. four-year colleges at a rate slightly lower than students at all California Community Colleges (CCCs). Chabot African American and Latino students usually transfer at similar rates than their counterparts in all CCCs; however, African American rates have recently dropped. This transfer rate is calculated for "transfer-directed" students, i.e., those who have completed 12 units and attempted a transfer-level English or Math course within 6 years of entering Chabot.

The transfer rate is the percentage of transfer-directed students who transferred to any 4-year college in the U.S. within a number of years after entering Chabot. Chabot's latest transfer rate is 25 percent after 4 years, and 37 percent after 6 years. The latest transfer rate for African American and Latino students is 22 and 28 percent respectively after six years.
