

Chabot College Student Satisfaction Survey: Fall 2017 Highlights

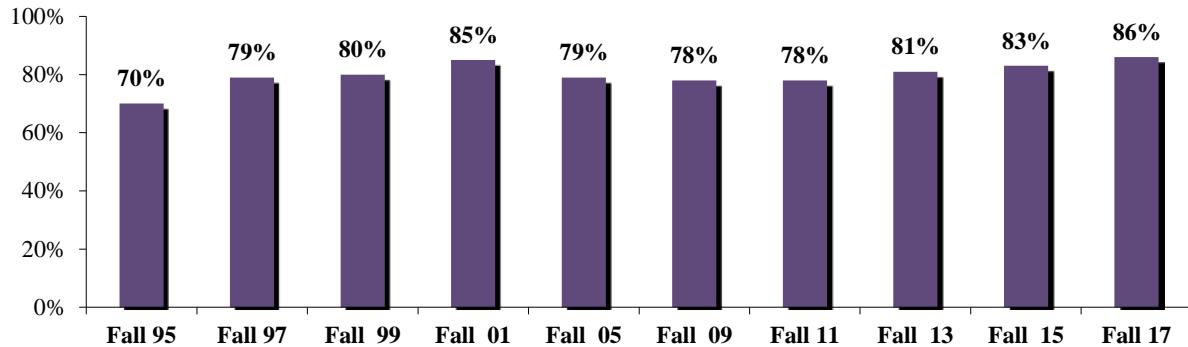
Student Satisfaction with Chabot Rises to Highest in 20 years

Student satisfaction with Chabot keeps rising! In Fall 2017, Chabot students reported the highest satisfaction with Chabot College in over twenty years—86 percent—after a steady rise over the last six years.

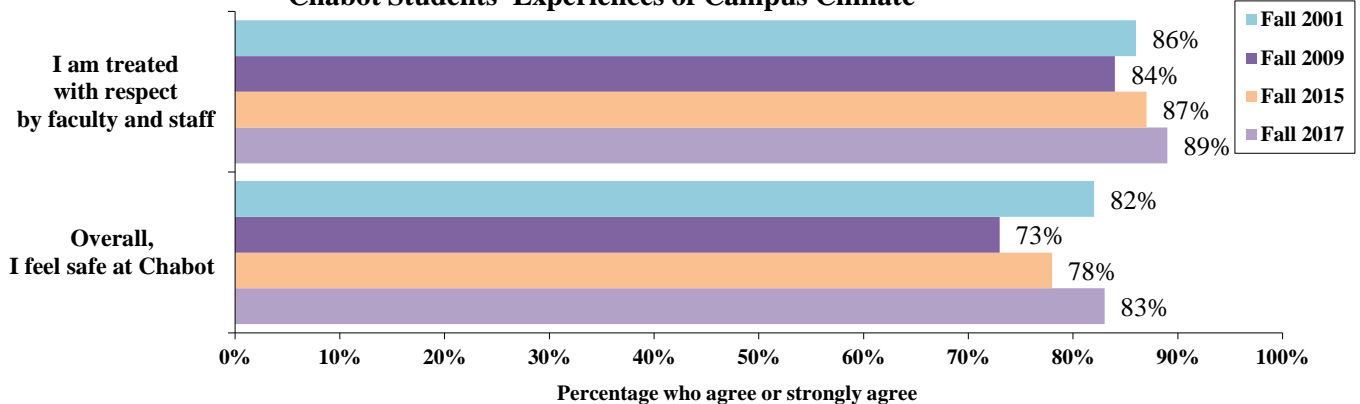
The last time satisfaction was almost as high was in October 2001, right after 9/11/2001, when the campus pulled together to support all groups on campus. After a subsequent drop, overall satisfaction grew to this year's level. In addition, several aspects of campus climate — being treated with respect by faculty and staff, feeling safe on campus, and respect for differences in race-ethnicity and in gender — also surpassed their 2001 levels of satisfaction.

The Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted in October 2017 in a representative sample of 77 on-campus course sections. Surveys were completed by 1,702 students (59% full-time; 41% part-time).
