


Chabot College Survey of Spring 2019 Degree and Certificate Graduates

The Spring 2019 Transfer/Graduation Survey was completed by 337 students. This handout summarizes the results for the 308 students who received a degree or certificate--of whom 183 students received a degree or certificate *and* transferred (referred to as *Degree/Cert & Transfer* below) and 125 students received a degree or certificate but did not transfer (referred to as *Degree/Cert Only* below). The majority of degree earners (referred to as *Degree Only* below) completed their programs within four and a half years (68% for degree only students and 85% for degree & transfer students). For certificate earners, 87% of them completed their programs within three and a half years. While at Chabot, over half of the students attended every term, and the majority of them attended full-time or mix of full-time and part-time, whether or not they were working.
