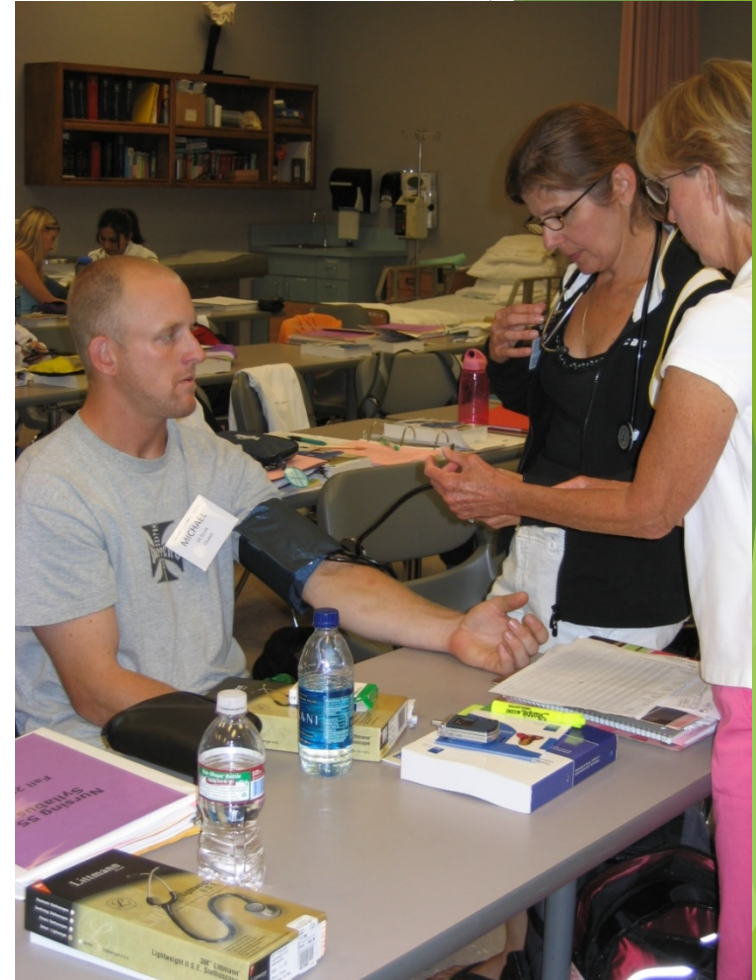

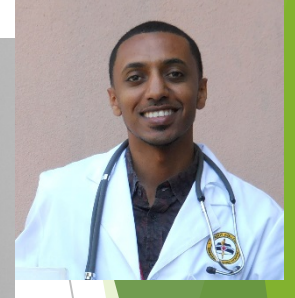

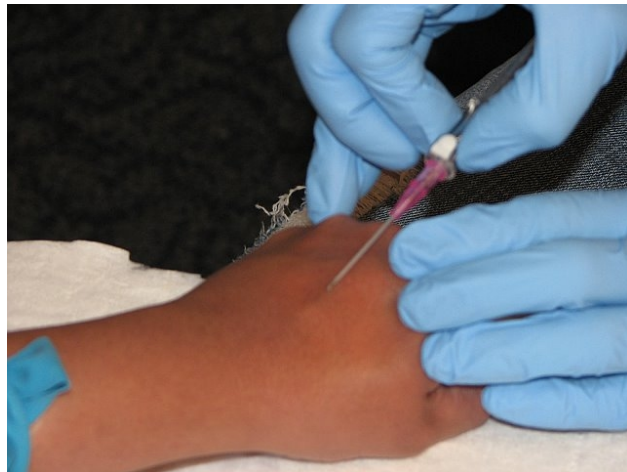

CHABOT COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM

Hayward Campus

- ▶ Nursing Program first class graduated in 1967.
- ▶ NCLEX pass rate 96-100% for past 10 years.
- ▶ Accepts 40-43 Students each Fall semester (August).
- ▶ Full time program Monday thru Thursday with some evening and Friday rotations.

PRE-REQUISITES

- ▶ You are required to complete all seven pre-requisites prior to applying the nursing program.
- ▶ Completion date:
 - ▶ Fall 2020 - RN(Generic) December 31, 2019
- ▶ Sciences only
 - ▶ You may only earn one “C” in the three science pre-requisites. Science GPA required 2.5.
 - ▶ For one “W” or failing grade the student will have -2 points deducted. For more than one “W” or failing grade in these sciences, -5 points will be deducted.
 - ▶ There is a seven (7) year RECENCY requirement for any science courses completed.
 - ▶ Coursework must be complete at a U.S. REGIONALLY ACCREDITED COLLEGE or UNIVERSITY
 - ▶ Upper Division Coursework will not be accepted (Board Policy 5016)

RN Generic Program:

SCIENCES COURSES

(4-5 semester units with a lab)

* ***Online labs will not be accepted***

- ▶ Anatomy 1: Human Anatomy
- ▶ Physiology 1: Human Physiology
- ▶ Microbiology 1: Microbiology
- ▶ Recency 7 years
 - ▶ Application Fall 2020 11/01/19 - 01/31/2020
 - ▶ Science completed **AFTER 08/01/2013**

Combined Science Classes/Repeats

- ▶ Single semester combined courses are not eligible: *Example:* Chabot Biology 50 is a combined A&P and will not meet the nursing requirement.
- ▶ If a one semester combined course is taken it does not count as repeat.
- ▶ Combined two semester Anatomy and Physiology courses should be taken at the same college.
 - ▶ ANAT & PHYS I and ANAT & PHYS II
- ▶ Upper Division Courses will not be accepted (CLPCCD Board Policy 5016)

Prerequisites-Fixed Courses

- ▶ English 1 or 1A: English Composition
- ▶ Sociology 1: Introduction to Sociology
- ▶ Psychology 1: Introduction to Psychology
- ▶ Communications 1 or 10 : Public Speaking or Interpersonal Communication.
- ▶ *Substitutions or waivers are not considered.*

Advanced Placement Classes from High School

- AP (Advanced Placement) tests in high school, we require an official sealed "transcript" directly from The College Board. (www.collegeboard.org).
- We will not take AP scores off other school's transcripts.
- Official AP transcripts are to be included in the Nursing Application envelope along with other official transcripts

To Apply...

- ▶ All prerequisites must be completed in by December 31st.
- ▶ Application will open November 1st until end of January.
- ▶ First apply to Chabot College and then the Nursing Program through Class-Web
- ▶ Applications are on line (Class-Web)
- ▶ Apply to other nursing programs also to increase chances
- ▶ Be aware of what a RN does before entering the program

ATI TEAS:

Test of Essential Academic Skills

- ▶ This is a normed, standardized predictive test in basic English, reading and comprehension, science, math and spelling.
- ▶ Similar to an SAT test just different topics
- ▶ New TEAS test was released in August 2016. CA CHANCELLOR'S OFFICE has approved the test ATI TEAS beginning 1/1/17.
 - ▶ Yes, if you have taken TEAS V you will need to take the newer version.


ATI TEAS

- ▶ Chabot will offer the test in Fall 2020. See website for schedule (Jan/May).
- ▶ Passing score is 62%. If you score below this will need to meet with director for remediation plan.
- ▶ Must complete plan within 1 year.

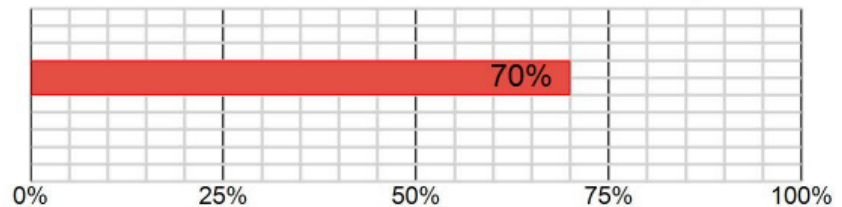

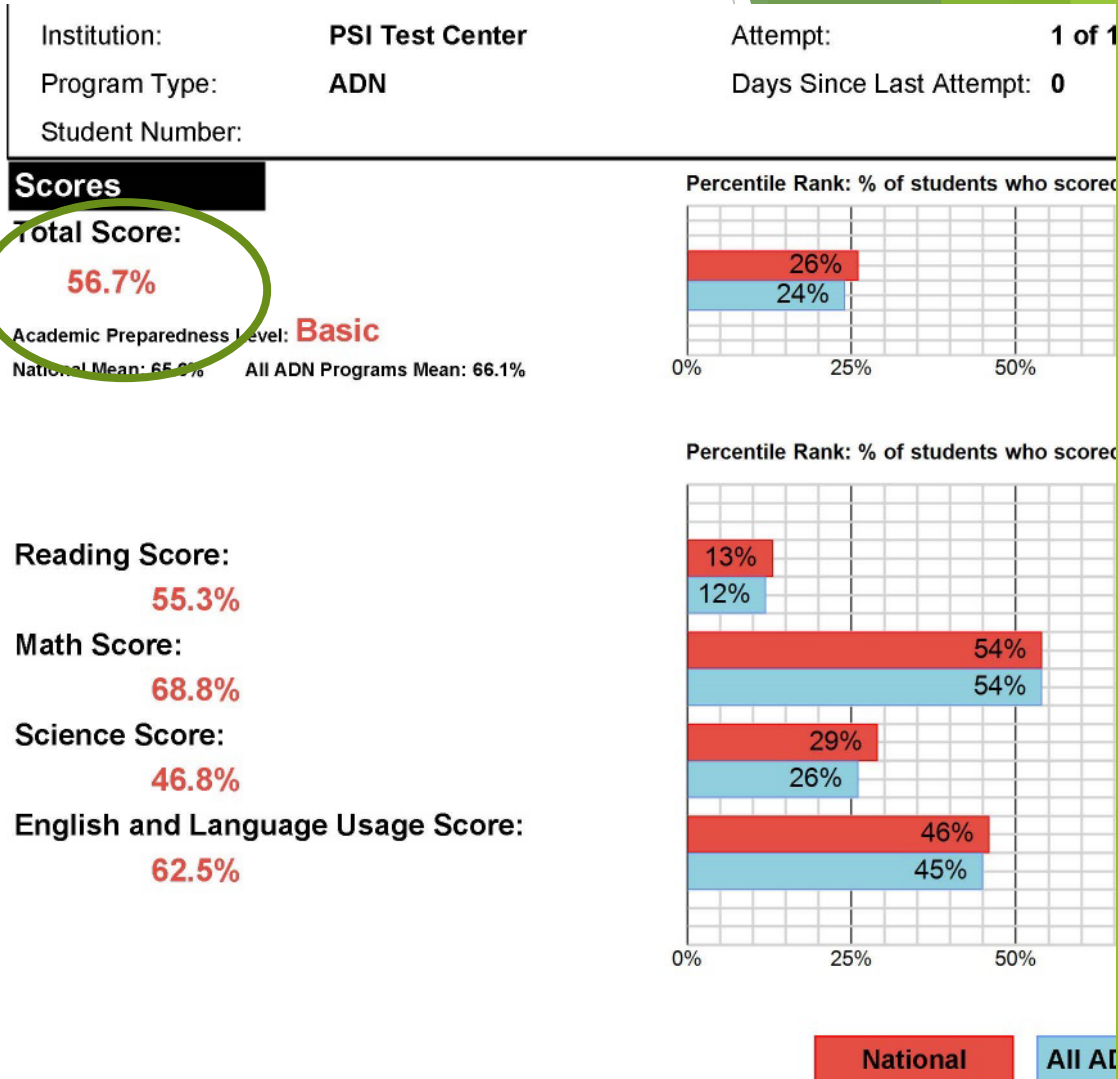

Below Passing

- ▶ If you do not pass the test you must remediate.
- ▶ See Program Director
- ▶ Following successful remediation, the candidate must re-apply to the nursing program (just as before) and be TEAS-tested again.



Background Check and Drug Screen

Background check

- ▶ A background check for convictions of any crime (misdemeanor or felony)
- ▶ Must notify director if you have any convictions
- ▶ Depending on the conviction, a hospital may deny a student's access
- ▶ Report everything to the BRN

Drug Screen

- ▶ 10 panel urine drug screen
- ▶ If a drug screen is **POSITIVE** for non-prescription drugs you will not be eligible for the program
- ▶ Allowed one repeat if return is to dilute to process
- ▶ Marijuana is not a legal drug nationally. Testing positive, even if you have a prescription, will disqualify you from the program.

BRN Background Review

SELECTION PROCESS

- ▶ Nursing programs are competitive. California Nursing Programs use two different methods of selection
 - ▶ random selection
 - ▶ merit based selection (Chabot)
- ▶ In order to increase your chance of being admitted to a nursing program, you are encouraged to apply to several different Bay Area programs.

Selection Process details for Chabot

- ▶ Applicants will be ranked according to Criterion Score.
- ▶ Top 1/3 will be entered into a random lottery. 40 applicants and 50+ alternates will be selected and notified.
- ▶ Example: if 300 qualified applicants the top 1/3 or 100 go into a pool and 40 are randomly selected
- ▶ All applicants will be notified of their status by US Mail and through their Zonemail account.



 - ▶ Section 4: **Life**- 'ADN Admission Supporting Documentation' Form or see listing for items
 - ▶ Section 5: **Veteran**- DD214 Honorable Discharge
 - ▶ Section 6: **Language** - Transcripts or ADN form above
 - ▶ Section 7: **TEAS**- Submit unofficial ATI TEAS® Results.

- *Complete Online Nursing Program available November 1st until January 31st of each application year. You may submit this application only once.*
- *A completed application submission will generate confirmation number, print, and sign this page.*
- *No changes will be accepted. Duplicate submissions will void all submissions.*

APPLICATION Packet

▶ Application Checklist:

- ▶ Signed Nursing Application Confirmation Page,
 - ▶ Information Meeting Confirmation Ticket Attached
- ▶ Signed Criterion Cover Page, and any other documentation required for confirmation of points
- ▶ Official Transcripts, transcripts must be SEALED in original school envelope to be official.
- ▶ Unofficial ATI TEAS® results and/or ATI Transcript, and

▶ Chabot College

Make a copy of all materials for your records.

TRANSCRIPTS

- ▶ Review your transcripts for accuracy. They can not be corrected **AFTER** submitted.
- ▶ Important: Dates on your application must match exactly to your transcripts; Dates attended, and semester courses taken.
- ▶ Submitted with your nursing application packet
 - ▶ Except Chabot College or Las Positas College—we have transcripts from coursework taken at either college.
 - ▶ An official copy of ALL college transcripts and AP Transcripts.
 - ▶ Or a RECEIPT of online transcripts ordered.
- ▶ Hand carried transcripts or applications will **not** be accepted.

Electronic Transcripts

If the submitting college has an agreement with Chabot College you will find our name on their list when you order.

If the submitting college **does not** have an agreement with Chabot College and requires an email address use:

ccarcom@chabotcollege.edu

You must include a receipt of either transaction above with your application.

International Transcripts

If you have been educated in a country outside the US, you will need to have your transcripts officially evaluated by an evaluation agency....see a counselor for information.

You can chose to use or not use your international education. If you do not submit a transcript with the application you may not submit at a later date.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER RN APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED?

- ▶ **Initial review of packet, applicant notified by email and with postcard**
- ▶ **Second review and evaluation of packet submission for**
 - ▶ **Verification of degrees**
 - ▶ **Completion of pre-requisites**
 - ▶ **Calculation of overall Science GPA**
 - ▶ **Calculation of overall General Education GPA**
 - ▶ **Criterion Score Confirmed**
