	 Negative or Borderline Titer reports on MMR, or Varicella, require two (2) boosters of the vaccine 30 days apart.
	 Negative or Borderline Titer report on Hepatitis B requires two (2) boosters of the vaccine 30
	days apart and a final (1) booster six months from 2 nd booster. First two boosters only must
	be complete by July 27, 2023.
	N95 Mask Fit test at CCCMA Occupational Health Clinic (St. Rose Hospital) in Hayward or Well for Work Occupational Health Clinic (Washington Hospital) in Fremont. Cost is \$35. Please call for an appointment. We do not accept any other N95 fit test.

	Certification. A copy of the E-card online certification of course completion must be submitted. If you are

	Clinical assignments are made by the faculty. During your two years in the program you will rotate through different hospitals and clinical settings. Clinical schedules vary and are based on each facility and their
	availability. You may be scheduled on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays beginning in September. Clinical
	Shifts: Day shift: between 6:45 am to 12:30 pm and Evening shift: between 2:00 pm to 8:30 pm. You may be
	scheduled for one 10-12 hour clinical shift, time to be determined. If you are scheduled for a 10-12 hour shift
	or evening shift, we will strive to alert you four weeks in advance. Please note this may change based on hospital availability.

Uniforms/Equipment:

- Uniform requirements will be discussed during June 14th orientation. You will be required to purchase 3 different uniforms:
 - Seal Blue scrubs for lecture/skills;
 - White scrub tops with uniform patches and Black scrub pants for clinical;
 - o Program polo shirts for mental health, outside events and clinics.
 - Equipment will include a watch with a sweep second hand, stethoscope and short white lab coat (30" or less in length).
 - Hospital name tags will be purchased at the June 14th orientation (\$20) and Chabot Student ID cards are required (Building 700, bring your nursing acceptance letter)

- TEAS results: Order your official TEAS results from ATI.com. It will be emailed to Chabot College.
 - a. If you have repeated the test, please also email a copy of your ATI transcript to the program RNProgram@chabotcollege.edu This report will list the TEAS testing results for all testing.
 - b. If you have taken the test at Chabot College indicate the word CHABOT on the acceptance file after you state the score.
- Receipt for payment of Background Request \$111.75: CastleBranch; see website for the background flyer for information and procedures. After payment has been made you have 48 hours to complete your drug screen. Drug screen form and drug testing lab location will be emailed directly to the nursing student from CastleBranch.

June 14th, 2023

July 30th, 2023

- All immunization requirements must be completed and uploaded in PDF format to CastleBranch. Do NOT take pictures of your forms. Use a scanner or an APP on your phone to create a PDF.
- □ Submit Original forms to program office. On July 30th all forms should have been scanned (PDF) and uploaded to CastleBranch. Do not take pictures of the forms. They must be scanned to create a legible PDF.
 - Completed medical forms signed by your M.D. or nurse practitioner.
 - Quantitative Lab reports for titers; MMR, Varicella, and Hepatitis B and boosters if required.
 - Immunization or shot records TdaP and COVID
 - N95 Mask Fit test results and certification.
 - Additional forms: N55 Release, Simulation Confidentiality Consent, and Nature & Scope Acknowledgment.
 - Flu- WAIT until Sept/Oct for the seasonal flu vaccination.
 - COVID Vaccine

Payment Due at the program office for program polo shirts: Uniform Shirts (set (2) for \$75). Students will be required to wear beige "docker" style long pants or dress pants with the uniform shirt while representing Chabot College. Polo Shirt Order form is available with the online incoming student packet.
