California Board of Registered Nursing

The California Board of Registered Nursing Requirements for licensure total 76.5 units including 43.5 units in the nursing major. It is recommended these general education courses be completed prior to program entry but must be completed prior to graduation for eligibility for RN certification.

General Education Courses: Refer to catalog sections on Graduation Requirements. Please note not all LPC course(s) are transferable. In orientation this summer you will complete a "Request for Graduation Evaluation" to review your transcripts for graduation requirements.

*Academic (less than 73%) or clinical (NC) failures in any of nursing program classes will require the student to withdraw from all classes in the program. The students not passing N55 or any other first semester courses must apply again. Incoming fall 2018 selection process may have changed. Please review to determine your eligibility if you fail any course in the first semester and need to apply again.

❶ If you have taken any other nursing courses you wish to substitute, the Request for Substitution forms, unofficial transcript, and course taken syllabus must be submitted by 08/01/2017. Once the program begins you will **NOT** be allowed to substitute any nursing courses for courses taken after 08/01/2017.
