- 2 2018-2019 standard budget includes \$46 per unit enrollment fee, 12 units / \$552 per semester, \$1,104 per year as an average, each semester has a different number of units required and total 47.5 units.
- 3 We include "extra fees or costs, such as lab fees, established for all students in a program" Health Fee, Student fees, lab fees.
- 4 Uniforms includes polo shirts, white scrubs and blue scrubs uniforms, 3 school patches, lab coat, shoes, stethoscope, scissors/pocket pack, watch with a "sweep" second hand, and name tag.
- 5 Kaplan tests and application for RN license and NCLEX examination fees. We are able to include "one time direct costs of obtaining a first professional license for students who are enrolled in program that requires such professional licensure or certification. This allowance may only be provided one time per student per eligible academic program. The cost must be incurred during (not after) period of enrollment, even if exam is after end of period."

Additional expenses not included above:

Fees for physical examination (\$250) and BLS(\$100) class are required **before** entry into the nursing program, and not permitted expenses in the cost of attendance. Guestimate is \$550 in medical costs for students without insurance.
