- Guides decisions about growth, development, and resource allocation
- Informs the District-wide Strategic Plan (DSP)


Overall Timeline

Chabot College EMP Structure





Component 2: Environmental Scan


- Local population demographics and changes (age, race, income, education level, etc.)



Definitions

- <u>Mission Critical Priorities</u> broad/global areas to guide the focus of college work, demonstrated connection to mission (10,000 ft level) recognizable by 1-word or short phrase with short description.
- Objective the 'what' describing the work to be done that aligns with the mission critical priority SMART: specific, measurable, actionable, realistic, timely
 - Builds on/specifies the *Strategic Plan* objectives
 - Ties to outcome measures
 - Connects/integrates the work of multiple programs or department
- <u>Strategy</u> the 'how' actions to accomplish the objectives
 - Integrates/builds on/specifies Strategic Plan strategies
 - Can define who is involved, what is the tangible action(s) needed to reach the objective.
- **Getting very specific to programs/services/area will happen in program review, where a program or area does their own granular planning to align with the EMP**




