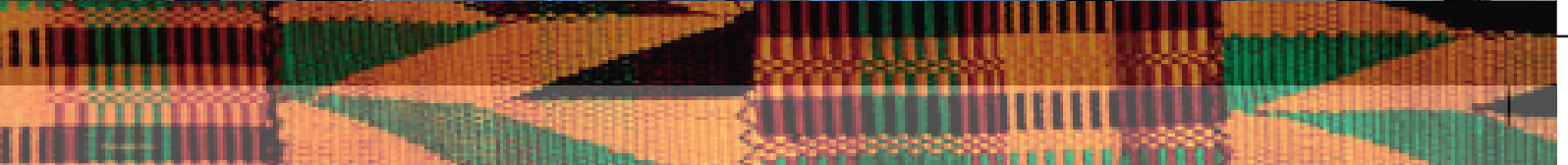




A network of support built just for you!

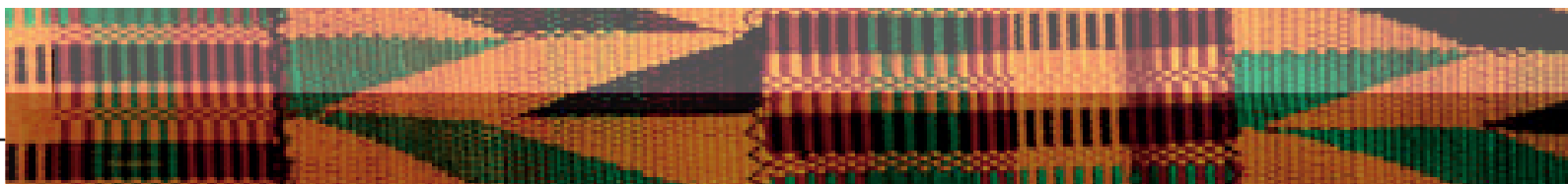

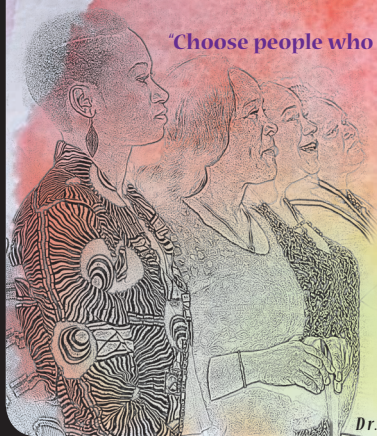
This monthly forum educates and empowers African American women to explore self-identity, feel a sense of belonging, and understand the importance of giving back to the community.
